The Secretariat of the United Nations presents its compliments to the Permanent Missions of Member States to the United Nations and invites Member States to recommend qualified individuals to serve on the Panel of Experts established pursuant to resolution 2374 (2017) on Mali, and extended by resolution 2541 (2020), subject to the extension of its mandate by the Security Council in August 2021 in pursuance of paragraph 3 of resolution 2541 (2020). The Panel of Experts on Mali, which is comprised of four experts, operates under the direction of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution

Recommended candidates should possess a minimum of **ten years** of progressively responsible experience, with a minimum of three years of field experience, in the below mentioned relevant areas of expertise and competence:

- · armed groups,
- finance,
- · humanitarian affairs,
- · regional issues.

The election process will include an interview and other assessment methods to evaluate candidates' suitability. Sanctions experts are selected on the basis of demonstrated expertise in the relevant area of work, experience and educational background, with due regard to equitable geographic representation and gender balance. English and French are the working languages of the United Nations Secretariat. For the above-mentioned positions, fluency in English and French is required; knowledge of Bambara is an advantage.

Appointment duration is in accordance with the mandate of the expert panel established by the Security Council. Experts are hired as consultants in line with the United Nations' administrative instruction concerning consultants and individual contractors (ST/AI/2013/4).
