The Consultant will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- General experience in economics, sociology, or a closely related field;
- Experience in monitoring and evaluation of development projects and in monitoring and evaluation of cash bases assistance programs / social assistance is a plus;
- Strong understanding of M&E frameworks and its role in project implementation;
- Experience in working on World Bank projects is desirable;
- Experience in working with the public sector in social protection domain is desirable;
- Ability to interact and communicate effectively with senior government staff;

- Ability to carry out assignments in accordance with instructions and guidelines;
- Ability to conduct analysis using qualitative and quantitative techniques;
- Strong interpersonal skills and pro-active approach to problem solving;
- Written and verbal communication skills;
- Knowledge and practical experience using Microsoft Office and project planning software; and statistical applications (SPSS, STATA) is a plus;
- Fluency in Arabic and English; fluency in French is a plus.

The expression of interest should be in the form of candidate's CV. Once the short-list is finalized, interviews are expected to be conducted in order to finalize the selection process. Negotiations of the terms of the contract are expected to be conducted in February 2022.
